



Job Posting Title: Field Organizer, Campaign for Homeless Services

Be part of something big. Across our community, people from all backgrounds are finding it hard to afford a safe, decent place to live and on any given night more than 5,000 - 12,000 families experience homelessness. Stable, affordable housing is essential to strong, vibrant families and communities. This May voters will have the opportunity to approve a measure that will provide access supportive services and affordable housing for people experiencing homelessness and provide prevention for families at heightened risk of homelessness.

Responsibilities:

Working with campaign leadership, you will execute a county-level volunteer field and partner outreach plan. This includes managing and coordinating the following activities:

- organize and motivate coalition partners and supporters to plan volunteer and voter outreach events
- deepen and expand the HereTogether coalition, especially by reaching networks with BIPOC communities and culturally specific providers
- give public presentations to community groups and general public
- manage sign and materials distribution
- coordinate and manage voter contact events
- recruit and train volunteers for voter contact activities (SMS, door-to-door, digital, phone)
- represent the campaign at community events
- meet volunteer and voter contact goals
- assist with endorsements

Requirements:

The successful candidate will be able to demonstrate that they possess:

- a passion for addressing our community's homeless crisis
- ability to motivate and encourage others
- strong oral and written communication skills

- experience working with and training volunteers
- experience with or ability to quickly learn how to use Voter Activation Network software
- strong organizational skills, including experience using database software to manage contacts, pledges, and progress
- flexibility to work long hours, including evenings and weekends
- the ability to work with a team and deliver thoughtful recommendations
- the ability to coach individuals on voter communication strategies
- a passion for winning progressive policy reform
